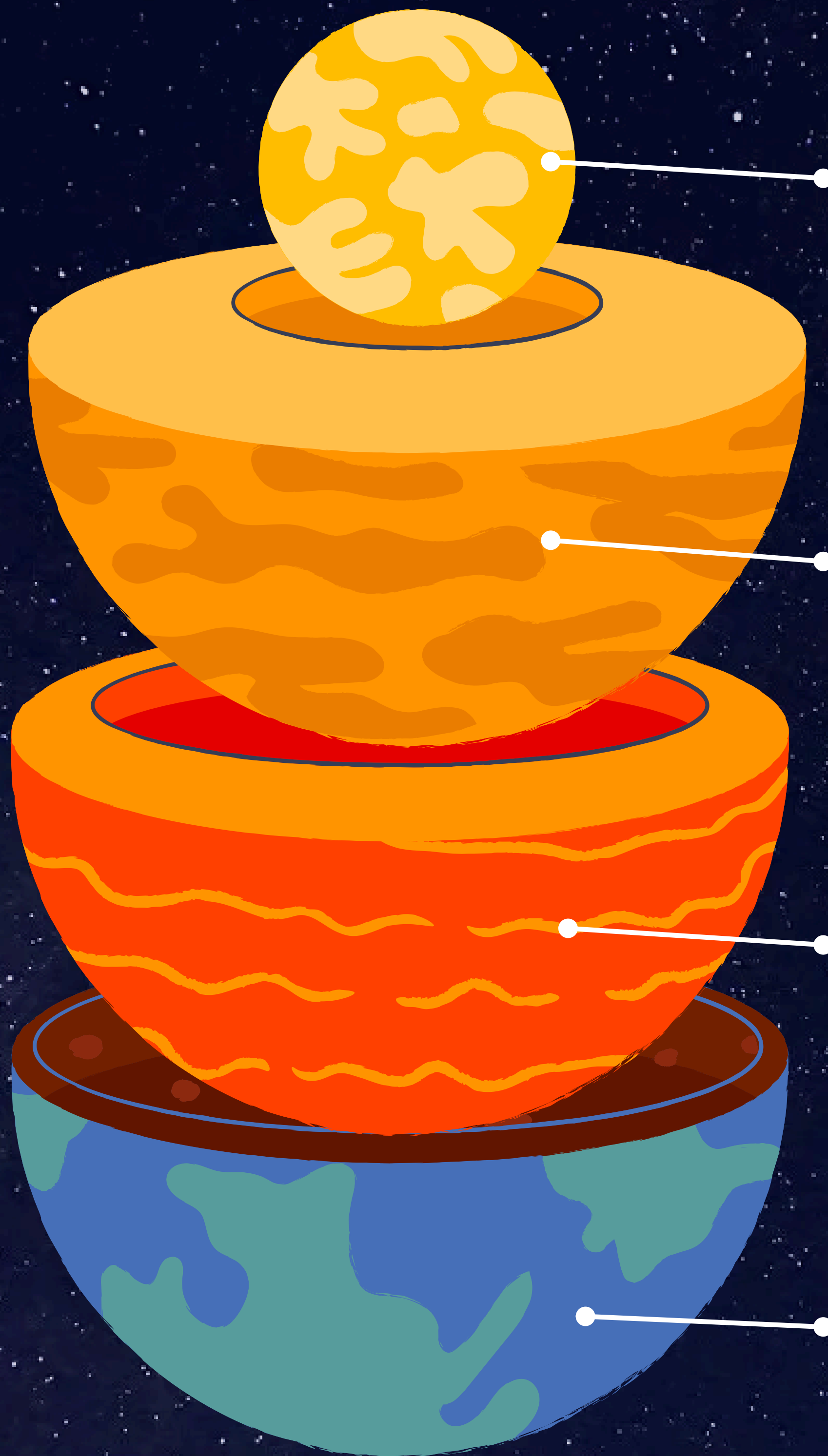


An Exploration into: **Earth's Layer**



Inner Core

At the very center of Earth lies the inner core, a dense, hot sphere of solid metal.

Outer Core

This layer is made of molten iron and nickel and is responsible for Earth's magnetic field.

Mantle

The mantle is Earth's largest layer, constituting about 84% of its volume. It is primarily solid, with some areas flowing like thick syrup.

Crust

The crust is the Earth's outermost layer, where all life exists. It forms the continents and ocean floors.
