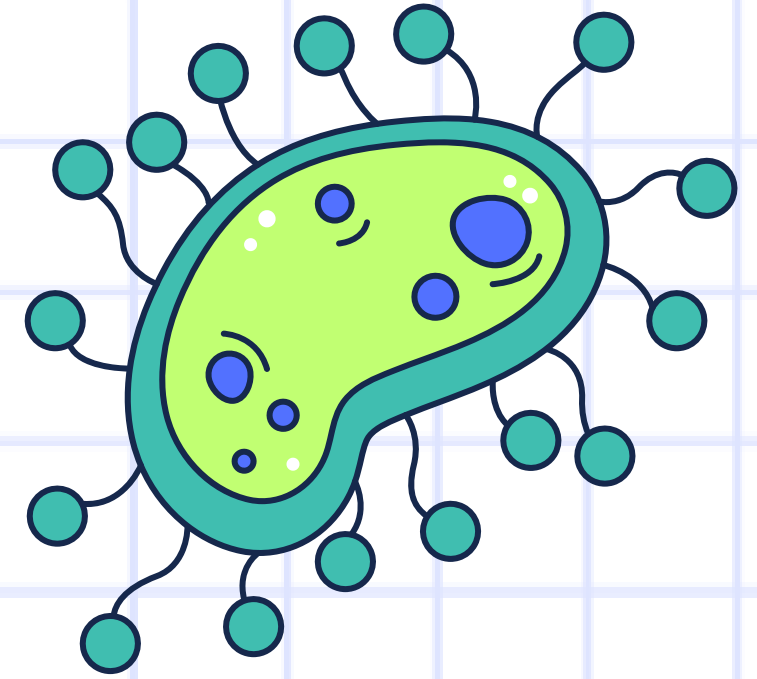


PATHOGENS

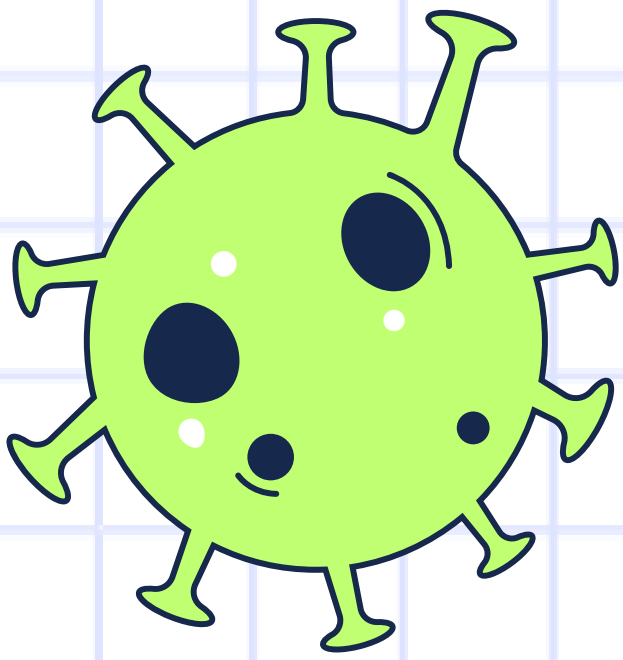
BACTERIA

Bacteria are single-celled prokaryotic organisms. Bacterial diseases can be treated with antibiotics. Some bacteria are useful.



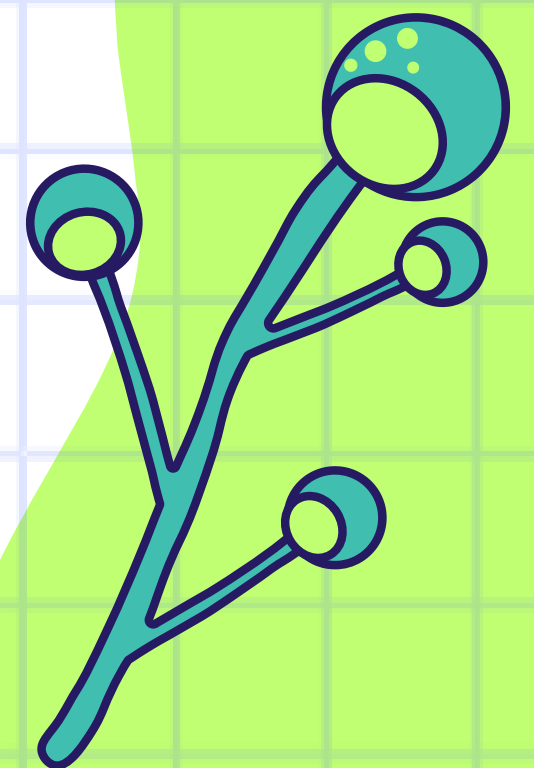
VIRUSES

Viruses are tiny infectious non-cellular organisms, which replicate inside living host cells e.g. foot and mouth disease.



FUNGI

Fungi are a large group of eukaryotic organisms that includes yeasts, molds and mushrooms. They can vary drastically in size.



PROTISTS

Protists are a group of eukaryotic, mostly single-celled organisms, which have features belonging to animals, plants and fungi.
